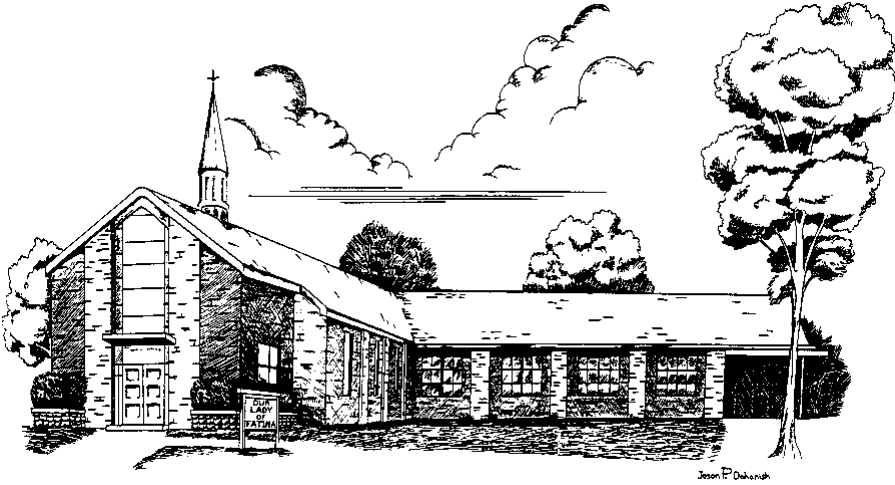

## **SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY**

Saint John, who was in the Upper Room with the other disciples on the evening of the first day after the Sabbath, tells us that Jesus came and stood among them, and said, "Peace be with you!" He showed them his hands and his side (Jn 20:19-20); he showed them his wounds. In this way they realized that they were not having an apparition. It was truly the Lord.

On the eighth day after Easter, Jesus came once again into the Upper Room and showed his wounds to Thomas, so that Thomas could touch them as he had wished. Through that physical touching, Thomas became a full witness to the Resurrection. A few years ago, Saint John Paul II decided to dedicate the Sunday after Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday. The wounds of Jesus Christ are wounds of mercy. They are to be seen and touched.

Jesus invites us to enter into the mystery of these wounds. In them we see all of Christ's role as the center of Salvation History: His Passion, His Incarnation, the course of His public ministry, filled with compassion for the weak and the sick. We can trace the prophecies – especially those announcing the Suffering Servant of the Lord.

At times, the world and humanity's evil can instill in us a feeling of emptiness. We feel empty of love, empty of goodness, empty of life itself. How can we fill this joyless abyss? Jesus, God made man, overwhelms the abyss of sin with the depth of his mercy.

The world is changed beginning with the conversion of one's own heart. Whether faced with my own sins or the great tragedies of the world, "my conscience would be distressed, but it would not be in turmoil." ***Peace be with you!*** The apostles, His followers, locked away and frightened, found Him in their midst. They came in contact with the glorified wounds of Christ and were able to be no longer followers but leaders. Resurrection of the dead is a stumbling block for many people. The infinite scope of God's mercy is even harder. So, we have the wounds, the glorified human wounds to help us to see and know the unfathomable love of God.
