## **THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Today's gospel story of the raising of the daughter of Jairus is interrupted by the account of the cure of the woman with hemorrhages. The twelve-year old girl and the twelve-year long suffering of the despairing woman depict the power of faith in two extreme situations.

The father of the child comes to Jesus when his daughter is at the point of death – a last resort. It seems that Jesus is too late to rescue her. Still, Jairus defies the odds and comes boldly to Jesus.

Because of her illness the unidentified woman is shunned religiously and socially. Her condition proscribes her from entering into any kind of communal life. She, too, is at the point of death because of her chronic illness. Because her disease forces her to the margins of society, it is necessary for her to approach Jesus furtively. She touches the hem of his garment in fear and trembling. Healing power flows into her.

The catalyst in both stories is faith. The faith of the grieving father and the faith of the desperate woman. Faith is our response to the God who reveals Himself in Jesus Christ. In Jesus, we see God address us, move among us, touch us. Our God is a God of Love, the God who heals when we reach out to Him. The power of faith is never too little nor too late.

## **R.C.I.A**

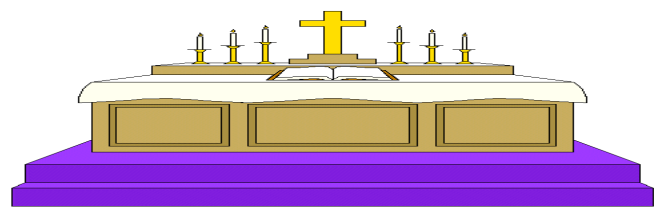
