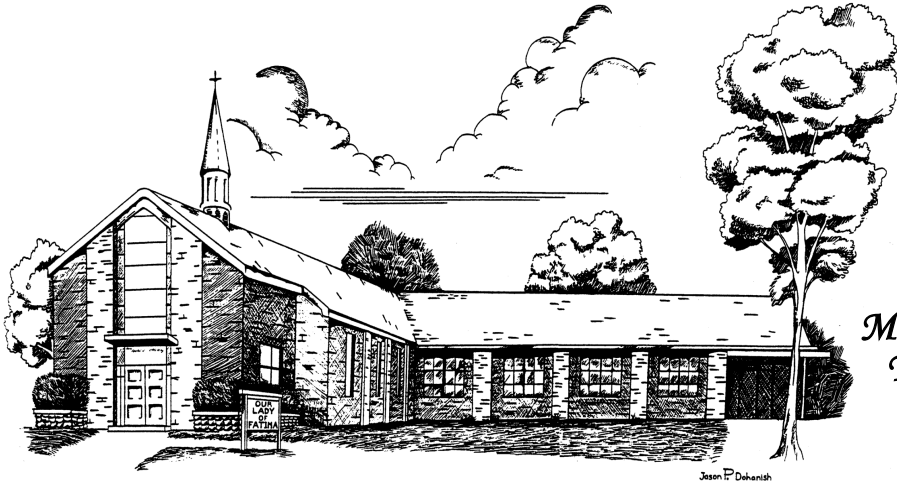

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

There are two categories of human reality that have been observed since the earliest cave dwellers. These categories denote the sacred and the profane. The idea is that the ordinary, the things of the world, the mundane, taint the sacred. The sacred has always been kept separate and pure.

In today's gospel, Jesus sends the twelve disciples on a mission to bring the sacred into the profane. In Jewish tradition, when a person entered the temple, he removed his outer clothes and his sandals as an indication of leaving the world outside. In a reversal, Jesus is sending His messengers in the guise of making the world participate in the sacred. They shed worldly clothes and attitudes. They bring holiness with them.

Their assignment was to preach one important word: Repent! They gave authority to that word by cleansing the world of demons and diseases. Two sacred activities.

God imbued the world with goodness at Creation. It was the place that He dwelled. After the Fall, things separated. Jesus Christ came to restore the unity of the sacred and the profane through a presence in the world and an attitude of repentance. The disciples were sent to make all things new again. So are we, through our perseverance in promoting holiness.

RCIA is the program of preparation open to anyone who would like to become a full member of the Catholic Church. Please contact our parish office, or Father Ricardo for more information.

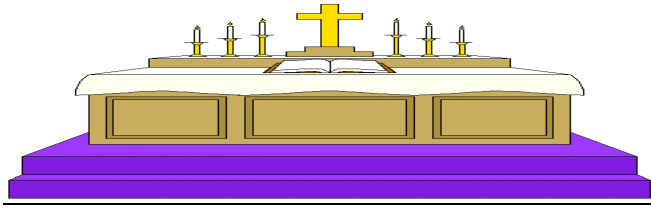
