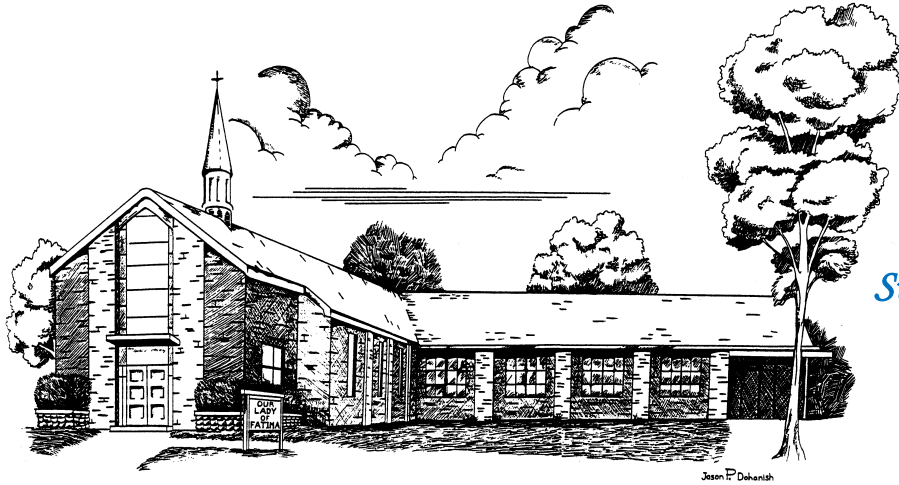

### LABORERS FOR THE HARVEST

Every baptized person is called to spread the gospel. Before the Ascension, Jesus instructed His followers: "Go and make disciples of all nations."

In today's passage from St. Luke, we see the sense of mission and movement that Jesus ordained for His workers. They needed to start with energy to push out the boundaries. Bearing a message of peace, giving love and healing to the sick, and subsequently, we are to assure the people of the world that the Kingdom of God is here and to excite them to work with and for it.

Even though we are in a scandalous, secular, and sinful environment, we are the "advance men and women" of that Kingdom. Proclaiming the Kingdom is not just for the ministers of the Church. Baptism made us each priest, prophet, and kingly. We are called to get the word out. We are required to assist and serve.

What is the "narrative", "the platform" of evangelizing Christians. Just the fundamentals: God, Jesus, sin, salvation, faith, prayer, the Eucharist, Scripture, the Church. This is our Good News!
