MARY AND MARTHA

At some time or other, anyone who has hosted a large group sympathizes with Martha. Worried and burdened, she has been trying to be of service to Jesus and His followers. She is giving her time, her talent, and her gifts.

When she appeals to Jesus for recognition of her efforts and asks for assistance from her sister, we can imagine that the Lord's response gives her a sting of hurt feelings. Those of us who serve our families, our parishes, and communities have all been through a moment or more of feeling unappreciated

In our gospel, Jesus was on His last trip to Jerusalem. He was on His way to suffer and die. He had paused at Bethany to be together – for the last time – with Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. He had come to be strengthened by their loyal and loving friendship.

Over the past few Sundays, we have seen that Christian service is a requirement. This week we find that we must discover the service needed. We don't get to choose how and what to do for a person in need. We are directed to enter the heart of the person we serve and respond to the real need. Jesus wanted to be heard. Mary listened. Jesus wanted to be joined in prayer. Mary prayed. Martha had chosen her service according to what she saw as necessary. It became a worry and a burden.

Often, we serve with listening and prayer.

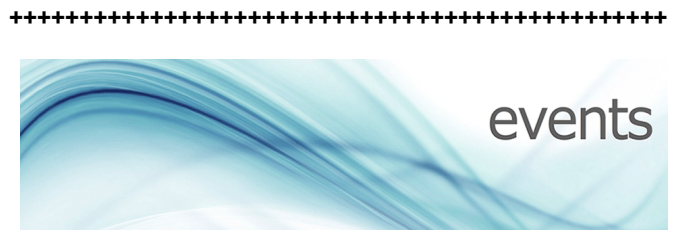
