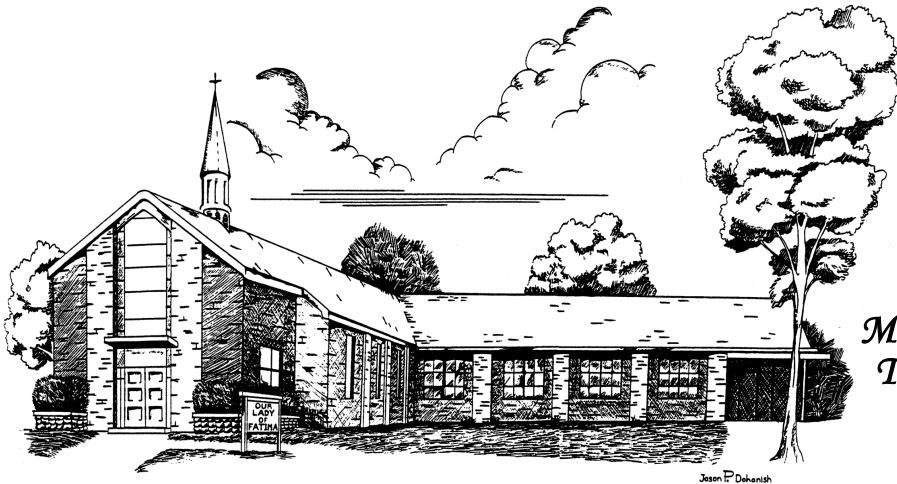

## **FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Knowing about Christ is not the same thing as knowing Christ. Today's gospel emphasizes this human truth. Jesus goes for a visit to His hometown. He arrives as a traveling teacher with a circle of disciples – a rabbi. By this time, He has not only been teaching, but has gained fame as a healer. Nevertheless, His friends and neighbors dismiss Him. (There are no severer critics than hometown acquaintances).

Jesus had lived in Nazareth for thirty years. He worked as a craftsman, a carpenter. He shared the conditions of village life. He was viewed as a working man, a man of the people, certainly not someone special. The villagers took offense at His new status.

The people of Nazareth were trapped. They stood too near Jesus; they couldn't see His greatness. They judged Him by externals and didn't see His true worth. Because of the atmosphere of incredulity, there could be no preaching, no miracles. Nazareth had no environment of expectancy.

The kind of faith required to experience miracles is not just an intellectual conviction. True faith is a passionate belief which makes a person spend all that he is and all that he has on that belief. True faith produces miraculous results. The only way to have authentic faith is to have a genuine relationship with Jesus. Divine power is not magical; it is relational. On our part, we are called to cooperate with grace. Our cooperation invites God into an environment where He performs mighty deeds. Faith opens the door to Jesus.

### **R.C.I.A**

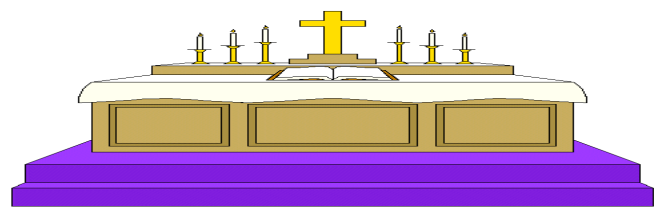
RCIA is the program of preparation open to anyone who would like to become a full member of the Catholic Church. Please contact our parish office, or Father Ricardo for more information.
